	You know what you are saying
	You really are the character
	You know who you are talking to and why
	Emotion matches what you are saying
	Prior moment is clear
	Connection to your partner
	Body language matches the character
	You can fix it if you make a mistake
	Don't get distracted (stay focused)
	Know your objective and go for it
	Appropriate volume
CHECKLIST: MONOLOGUE PERFORMANCE CRITERIA	
	Remain in character throughout
	Be completely off-book
	Be able to improvise without breaking character if you lose a line.
	Prior moment is clear
	There is a sense of urgency- a true need to speak
	You are truly working to achieve your objective, possibly trying several different tactics
	Strong connection to your partner
	Use of voice and body matches the character's needs and objectives
