



Drawing criteria

- 1. The eyes on the middle line between the top of the head and the chin
- 1. You can fit 5 eyes across
- 2. The nose half way between the eyes and the chin
- The ears are in frontal view, and between the line of the eyes and the bottom of the nose
- 4. The hair is drawn from the forehead to the front of the ears
- The distance within the shoulders, is proportional to three times the width of the head
- 6. The neck lines are almost equal to the side of 3 eyes
- The drawing shows details that demonstrated Colonial style in the hair, moustache, sideburns, clothing, or head cover

- 1. Forehead (sides)
- 2. Above eyes
- 3. Under nose
- 4. Under lips
- 5. Sides of face
- 6. Sides of neck
